Part XXIII

Breaking the Blame and Shame Game

This month, I take you through the Door into my past – and, gods willing, your present and future.

I happen to be one of those people who tells anyone who seems interested about who I am and how I got here. You probably know that already from reading this article.

At some point in my childhood, my mother revealed herself to my father as being crazy. He took her to the doctor (after patching the walls where the pots and pans struck them after missing him), and the doctor's reasoned suggestion was, "throw her in the State Hospital and lose the key." (My mother told me about this just a few years ago, the first time she had ever admitted this imperfection.) My father refused to do so, and so I grew up with my mother – diagnosed, but untreated. She refuses psychiatric medications to this day – and perhaps that is where I got my stubbornness on this issue.

But while I was growing up, my mother's "condition" caused her to pass a wide variety of mixed messages to me and my brother. To be blunt, I never knew what was "good" and what was "bad", and from about the age of 5 I was spanked for being "bad" when my father got home.

There are few things more disempowering to a young child than being beaten without knowing what you did wrong. I tried and tried and tried to be "good", only to get spanked again. After a while, perversity set in. It was much easier to determine what was "bad" than what was "good" (or "not bad"). I was going to get a spanking anyhow, so I might as well do something so that I "deserved it".

I got just as many spankings. But I thought I didn't feel so bad about it, because I deserved it now.

Later, as I got older, kids started picking on me. My parents discouraged physical violence (unless Dad did it to me under controlled conditions), so I was told not to fight back. Most of the abuse was verbal. So I did what I was trained to do – I started picking on myself. I told myself, "It won't hurt so much if I know what they're going to say and say it first."

You know what? It took me a lot of years but, as you've read in my articles, I finally figured out that all I was doing was training myself to *curse* myself. The hardest thing to do that started my recovery was the easiest – stop putting myself down. No matter where the abuse comes from, it hurts. In fact, coming from myself, the abuse had a direct channel to my Younger Self, or subconscious mind, so it likely hurt me **more** than if it came from someone else.

All of this came back to me the other night as I was reading one of the Great Books of Our Time, Rob Brezsny's *Pronoia (How the Whole World Is Conspiring to Shower You with Blessings)*. On page 253 (first editition), he gave me the codification of my Next Step in Recovery.

Say these words with me, or by yourself.

I will never again cast a curse on myself.

Being Pagan, most of us know that true Words of Power must be said three times, with intent.

I will never again cast a curse on myself.

There. Feeling better now? I sure am.

Rob included a poem shortly after this magickal statement. I suggest you read it aloud, dedicating it to yourself:

I love my strange beauty and amazing pain

I love my hungry soul and entertaining games I love my flaws, my gaps, my fears I love my mysterious, dazzling frontiers

I will never forsake, betray, or deceive myself
I will always adore, forgive, and believe in myself
I will never refuse, abandon, or scorn myself
I will always amuse, delight, and redeem myself


Beauty and truth and love will always find me Chaos and wilderness will always sustain me I'm the fire and water and earth and air that are forever fresh from eternity

The two national conventions are over – the two major candidates are picked. Members of both parties are very upset by who is their candidate – but the party that will do the most harm to Pagans – seem to be backing their candidate better than the party that will be best for Pagans to be in power. This is the time to look at the big pictures. Since this nor Dragon Palm Circle are tax exempt religious organizations we can speak out for our candidates of choice. (I've been staying away from that in earlier articles) (Note that tax exempt religious organizations such as church are not allowed to endorse or back political candidates – part of the separation of church and state – but like most pagan coven DPC is not tax exempt, nor is PAS – so we can support political candidates like any other group). Most Pagans lean to the left – we don't care the color of your skin, your sexual orientation, or your religious beliefs (as long as you don't try to get us to follow yours). Because of this many Pagans were backing Bernie Sanders – myself included. But Bernie did not make it as the Democratic candidate. Many of his followers have a attitude of – the Democrats deserve Trump for not voting for Bernie – we will not vote for the lessor to two evils...it's true that Hillary leans way too far to the right – but not as far as Trump – and the platform will be backing some liberal programs. Don't look at them as evils = but as who will be better for the US and for us. Will voting the Green Party help us or harm us. These are question you must ask yourself. Thank hard about what it would mean to have TRUMP for President. It could happen – and if it does who fault is it. The DNC for electing Hillary as their candidate or the person who stay home and not vote, or the person who votes for a third party candidate that has no chance of winning. 

We are lucky in Sevier county Tennessee, because we have the Gatlinburg Craft Circle. Several miles of stores selling local made items. Wood workers, candle makers, leather crafters and more. Need a broom – there are several shops that make brooms. Spend a day in the craft circle you are sure that you can find some very Pagan items. A favorite of mine is Misty Mountains Soap Company. Besides all kinds of home made soaps – they have a healing balm – that's all natural and really works! - Several different items that Lady Sky and I like here. Many of the stores change from time to time – so each time you visit you will find something new. Downtown Gatlinburg also has some interesting stores. At the Village Shops we have two stores we like a lot. Candle Cottage – they have the chime candles – which make great candles for spells and rituals – large choice of colors including gold and silver – also candle holders for them. They also have a lot of other types of candles . And the Celtic Heritage – a lot of great Irish and Scottish items. Have even found a real nice pentagram there. And you can always stop in for some coffee or tea at the Donut Friar.

Gatlinburg is a tourist city – like no other – you park and walk – attractions and stores – many are local craft stores worth looking around town.

Pigeon Forge also has a lot of interesting stores. Looking for crystals and stones – go to the Pigeon Forge Gem Mine. You can buy a bucket of dirt that's full of different stones – the stones in the buckets come from mines all over the world. And inside the gift shop there is one of the largest rock shops in the area, including a new age sections with spheres, wands, pendulums. And a very large selection of books on the healing properties of stones.

Old Time Pottery is another interesting store. Good prices and a lot of different types of items. Some nice incense and burners. A lot of sales and closeouts.

A lot of places that have cast iron – including cauldrons. Including Lodge Cast Iron have some outlet stores.

Now we have two major flea markets – on 66 we have Flea Traders Paradise – with both inside and outside vendors – many of the outside vendors are selling yard sale type stuff, so you can find all kinds of things. Inside there is a shop called the Bead Connection – they have a selection of charms – that include a lot of pagan charms. Again some of the stores will have that surprise – that you didn't expect.

The other Flea Market is the Great Smokys Flea Market on Dumplin Valley Road next to I40. This is a huge Flea market – with both outside and inside vendors. Many of the outside are changing from week to week, which means you get the yard sale type vendor.






TURNING TABLES
